Be Proactive with Colorectal Cancer Screening

Did you know that colorectal cancer is the third most serious type of cancer for both men and women? Early detection saves lives! Most colorectal screenings are considered a preventive service and covered at \$0 cost share.

As part of our ongoing 2025 Mind the Gap – Get Preventive Care Campaign, we're excited to announce a new partnership with Labcorp to offer **free** ColoFit kits to eligible members. If you haven't completed your colorectal screening within the recommended preventive schedule, you may qualify to receive a kit at no cost. A ColoFit kit is a convenient, at-home test that checks for hidden blood in your stool—an early indicator of potential colorectal issues, such as cancer.

Stay tuned, as eligible members will receive more information soon about how to take advantage of this opportunity.

Participants may manually log their miles by selecting "manual entry" when logged in to the portal.
